SOCIO-ECONOMIC RESEARCH AND ANALYSIS

Through her postgraduate dissertation research on meanwhile use of land in Paris and London, she conducted analysis on two large-scale meanwhile projects and drew conclusions based on extensive primary research with a range of stakeholders including local residents and public and private actors. Since joining Regeneris, Louise has undertaken research on the changing economy of Finsbury and Clerkenwell, combining economic and social research to explore the importance of creative industries and the retail economy in the area.

At Regeneris Louise continues to grow the policy evaluation skills she developed during her postgraduate studies. After collaborating with JustSpace on analysing the New London Plan's industrial land policy and formulating recommendations accordingly, Louise has also been part of the Regeneris team facilitating consultations and analysing responses for the GLA on the Mayor's Cultural Strategy.
